Around the Grounds



The club is now testing the track for firmness on a regular basis using a Klegg Hammer kindly provided by RWWA. This is a new innovation for harness racing tracks but will assist the track curator and team prepare the track on a daily basis.



Watch this space. We have been working on this area in getting it clean up and levelled out and then beautiful grass will be installed within the next few weeks. This will improve the look of the entrance and improve our grounds. We still have the top gardens to do in the future.



•Parade Ring Chute.
