The Harvey Cup is back

The Pinjarra Harness Racing Club is pleased to confirm the Harvey Cup will now take pride of place on its yearly racing calendar due to popular demand and support from Harvey residents and business owners.

A time-honoured race going back to the early 1900's, Pinjarra Harness Racing Club, with massive thanks to local Engineering company, Dwyer Engineering, The Harvey Cup will be run each year on Easter Monday at the Pinjarra Paceway.

Harvey District Trotting Club began running meetings continuously since 1927 when the club became affiliated with the Western Australian Trotting Association (WATA). In 1979, a new 800 metre track and buildings were built 3 kms north of Harvey.

Financial difficulties occurred during the late 1980's and with little support to continue, the Harvey District Trotting

Club had its final meeting in May 2014.

Dale Putland, General Manager of Pinjarra Harness Racing Club said" The Harvey Cup was an important and time honoured race on the Country Harness Racing Calendar and the club is thrilled to be able to bring the race back to life to recognise the Harvey Cup's history".

This year the race will be held on Easter Monday, 21 April and thanks to the generosity of Jack Dwyer and Dwyer Engineering to celebrate the day the club will be holding a free family fun day, with loads of kid's entertainment including face painting; free lollie bags and zooper doopers, live music and great racing.

Former club members and Harvey residents are encouraged to get along to the race day to celebrate the return of the Harvey Cup.

Nullabor Navajo become WA's fastest mare on Monday when she claimed the Dr Ed Dewar Golden Girls Mile in a very fast 1:50.6 for the mile.

Starting from barrier one, despite beginning well Nullabor Navajo ended up three back on the fence, but Penny Black drifting off the marker pegs up the back straight was able to get a clear run through and wear down race favourite and leader Steno close to the line.

Trained by emerging young local trainer Corey Peterson and driven by Stuart McDonald, Nullabor Navajo has now earned just over \$180,000 with 13 win from 57 starts.







A great buzzing day as always!


